3. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device when you visit a website. These files allow websites to recognize your browser or device and remember certain information about your visit.

Some cookies are necessary for websites to function correctly, while others help website owners analyse visitor behaviour, remember preferences or show personalised content and advertisements. Cookies generally make websites more user-friendly and efficient.

4. How we use cookies

Di Karibe may use cookies for several purposes. Certain cookies are essential for the operation and security of the website. Other cookies help us improve our website, understand visitor behaviour or personalise content and marketing.

For example, cookies may help us:

- remember your preferences;
- analyse website traffic;
- improve website performance;
- understand which pages are visited most often;

- integrate social media content;
- provide a smoother browsing experience.

We may use analytical services such as Google Analytics and social media integrations from platforms like Instagram, Facebook, LinkedIn or TikTok. Some third-party services may place cookies through our website. We do not control how these third parties process personal data and therefore recommend reviewing their own privacy and cookie policies as well.

5. Consent and cookie preferences

Under applicable privacy legislation, certain cookies may only be placed after you have given consent. When required, our website will ask for your permission before non-essential cookies are activated. You are free to accept, refuse or customise your cookie preferences at any time through your browser settings or the cookie banner on our website. Please note that disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality or performance of the website.

6. Managing or disabling cookies

Most internet browsers allow you to manage cookies through their settings. You can choose to block cookies completely, delete stored cookies or receive notifications whenever cookies are placed on your device. The exact way to manage cookies differs per browser and device. More information can usually be found in the help section of your browser.

Disabling cookies does not necessarily stop all online advertisements, but advertisements may become less personalised and more repetitive.

7. Your privacy rights

Under the GDPR, you have several rights regarding your personal data and the use of cookies. You may request access to the personal data we process about you and ask us to correct, delete or restrict certain data where legally possible. You also have the right to object to certain processing activities and to withdraw consent previously given.
