1. Who we are

Di Karibe is a creative business based in the Netherlands, focused on marketing, graphic design, branding and website design. We believe that creativity and trust go hand in hand. Whenever you visit our website, contact us or work with us, we want you to feel confident that your personal information is handled carefully, respectfully and securely. Sileyna Creative is registered with the Dutch Chamber of Commerce under number 85370177 and is located at Mandolinestraat 103, 2287 EV Rijswijk, The Netherlands.

2. What personal data we collect

The personal information we collect depends on the way you interact with us. For example, when you contact us by e-mail, request a quotation, become a client or visit our website, we may process certain personal data.

This may include your name, company information, e-mail address, telephone number, billing information and project-related materials. In some situations, we may also process photographs, videos or social media content that you voluntarily share with us for creative or marketing purposes. When you visit our website, technical information such as your IP address, browser type and website usage data may also be collected automatically through cookies or analytics tools.

3. Why we use your data

We use personal data to provide our services professionally and efficiently. This includes communicating with clients, preparing quotations and agreements, carrying out creative projects and managing our administration. Your information may also be used to improve our website and services, maintain contact with clients and comply with legal or administrative obligations. In some cases, we may use your information for marketing or portfolio purposes where this is legally permitted or where consent has been given.

We only process personal data where there is a valid legal basis under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), such as consent, contractual necessity, legal obligations or legitimate business interests.

4. Sharing of personal data

Di Karibe does not sell personal information to third parties. However, in order to operate our business and services properly, we may work with trusted external providers such as hosting companies, payment providers, cloud storage services, software providers or accountants.

Where personal data is shared with third parties, we ensure that appropriate agreements and safeguards are in place to protect your privacy and comply with applicable laws and regulations.

5. Storage and retention of data

We do not retain personal data longer than necessary for the purpose for which it was collected. Certain administrative information, such as invoices and payment records, must legally be retained for a number of years under Dutch tax legislation. Other personal data will be deleted or securely archived once it is no longer needed for our services, communication or legal protection.

Your information is generally stored within the European Economic Area (EEA). If personal data is transferred outside the EEA, we will ensure that appropriate legal safeguards are applied in accordance with the GDPR.

6. Cookies and website usage

Our website may use cookies and similar technologies to improve functionality, analyse website traffic and enhance user experience. Some cookies are necessary for the website to function properly, while others help us better understand how visitors use our website.

Third-party services such as Google Analytics or social media platforms may also place cookies through our website. Where legally required, we will request your consent before placing non-essential cookies. You can always manage or disable cookies through your browser settings.

7. Data security

We take the protection of personal data seriously and use appropriate technical and organisational measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorised access or disclosure of information.

Although we make every reasonable effort to secure our systems and communications, no online environment can ever be guaranteed completely secure. We therefore encourage users to also handle personal information carefully when communicating online.

8. Your privacy rights

Under the GDPR, you have several rights regarding your personal data. You may request access to your information, ask us to correct inaccurate data or request deletion of your data where legally possible. You also have the right to object to certain processing activities, withdraw previously given consent or request restriction or transfer of your data. If you wish to exercise one of these rights, you may contact us at contact@dikaribe.com. We aim to respond to requests within 30 days.

If you believe your privacy rights are being violated, you also have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority.

9. Children's privacy

Our services and website are not intentionally directed at children under the age of 16. If we become aware that personal data of a minor has been collected without the required consent where applicable, we will remove such information as soon as reasonably possible.

10. Changes to this privacy policy

Di Karibe may update this Privacy Policy from time to time due to changes in legislation, business activities or the way we process personal data. The most recent version will always be available through our website. We recommend reviewing this Privacy Policy regularly to stay informed about how your personal information is handled.
